

## DISCOVERING GARFAGNANA

A walk to catch the past and the present of this hidden corner of Tuscany

- WHEN: every **Saturday**, from April to October
- ◆ PARTICIPANTS: min 2 / max 16 persons
- ◆ LENGHT: 8 Km (5 miles)
- ITINERARY: downhill route through tracks, country paths and dirt roads
- ◆ START: 14.30 at the townhall of Villa Collemandina
- FACILITIES: bars and water supply in Villa Collemandina, Castiglione and Pieve Fosciana
- ◆ END: 18.00 in Pieve Fosciana
- ◆ GUIDE: Pierluigi Pellizzer, qualified local guide, member of Garfagnana Guide association, fluent English speaking
- ◆ PRICE (per person): 2-3 persons, 22 Euro / 4-6 persons, 12 Euro / 7-16 persons, 8 Euro. Cost covers the guiding service and should be paid before starting.



## **DESCRIPTION**

The walk is an easy itinerary through the picturesque villages of the valley. The qualified local guide will talk about the landscape, the history and the economy of Garfagnana, as:

- the Apuan Alps and Apennines mountains, with theirs parks and the marble quarries
- the economy of the valley: forests and pastures
- medieval villages, strongholds and fortresses
- a troubled history: from the Etruscans, through the Lombards, the duchy of Lucca and Modena
- the farro (emmer), the wheat's ancestor, the local protected product
- the chestnut process: the 'bread tree', the harvest, the '*Metato*' storing place
- local fairs and traditions
